In this issue, we have one review, five research articles, two case reports, and two letters to the editor. The review covers the DRESS syndrome in detail. The first research article shows the results of the investigation on the relationship of single nucleotide polymorphisms in the mammaglobin-A gene and nasal polyposis. The second article investigates the clinical features and follow-up results of patients with transient hypogammaglobulinemia of infancy and whether there is coexistence with allergic diseases. The third one is on eosinophilic esophagitis in young children.
