Dear colleagues,

The journal is published every April, August and December. We are pleased to present you the August 2022 issue of Asthma Allergy Immunology as the editorial board. In this issue of our journal, you will find eight research articles on the following subjects: the attitudes of the parents of patients receiving allergen-specific immunotherapy against anaphylaxis; association of the abo rh blood groups with allergic rhinitis and their distribution according to the allergen types; mepolizumab-related adverse events in severe eosinophilic asthma; topical steroid phobia among mothers of children with atopic dermatitis; the role of food allergy on maternal anxiety, stress, and depression; the effects of low eosinophil counts on the risk of transmission of sars-cov-2 after mepolizumab treatment in patients with severe asthma; differences of CSU with angioedema from CSU without angioedema in terms of clinical features and treatment response; and allergic and nonallergic rhinitis according to symptoms.
